News of the demise of our dear amiable Hon Emilia Monjowa Lifaka on 20th of April, 2021, came as a great shock to me. The death has caused grief to the Commonwealth Parliamentarian Association (CPA) in general and the Commonwealth Women Parliamentarians (CWP), Africa Region in particular.
